

Followings are steps to update the wireless pilot display app named **Mobile snapSHOT** on iPad Mini:

1. Make sure the app is closed
 - a. Double press Home button.
 - b. Swipe up all apps to close.
2. Uninstall the app
 - a. Long press the app icon on the bottom of the display to bring up pop up a dialogue like the following:



- b. Tap the **Delete App**
 - c. Tap **Delete** when prompted Delete “Mobile SnapSHOT”?
3. Switch Wi-Fi to one with Internet connectivity
 - a. Open **Settings** app
 - b. Go to **SETTINGS** → **Wi-Fi**
 - c. Select a Wi-Fi that has an Internet connectivity.
4. Download the new version of the pilot display app
 - a. Swipe to the left on the Home screen
 - b. Tap on Safari app
 - c. Tap on **NEW TAB**
 - d. Enter the following download page link at <https://trackair.us/mobile>
 - e. Tap on the gray Apple logo on the right
 - f. Tap on the download icon that looks like this 
 - g. When the download is completed, the download icon turns to Open
5. Press Home button
6. Move the newly install pilot display app to the app short cuts at the bottom of the display
 - a. Long press the Mobile snapSHOT app icon to bring up a pop up dialogue
 - b. Tap **Edit Home Screen**
 - c. Drag the icon to the middle of the dock located at the bottom of the display.

7. Switch Wi-Fi to the Wi-Fi attached to the computer running snapSHOT
 - a. Open **Settings** app
 - b. Go to **SETTINGS** → **Wi-Fi**
 - c. Select the Wi-Fi attached to the computer running snapSHOT.
 - d. Press the selected Wi-Fi
 - e. Tap **Configure IP**
 - f. Tap **Manual** to reveal additional settings
 - g. Under **IP Address**, tap and enter **192.168.0.16**
 - h. Under **Subnet Mask**, tap and enter **255.255.255.0**
 - i. Under **Router**, tap and enter **192.168.0.1**
 - j. Tap **Save** to save the settings
8. Close all the apps
 - a. Double press Home button
 - b. Swipe up all apps to close.
9. Run snapSHOT and open a flight plan on the Navigator display.
10. Open wireless pilot display by tapping  and it should load the flight plan currently opened in snapSHOT.
